Uttara University at a Glance

History

Situated in the outskirts of Dhaka City, Uttara University is a center of excellence for tertiary education in Bangladesh. It was started in 2003 with a few students and departments. But by now it has grown as a full-fledged university offering under-graduate and graduate programs and research opportunities. It is widely recognized nationally and internationally for its motto of quality education at affordable tuition. The graduates produced here and their job placements are the reflections of quality education at Uttara University. In this cosmopolitan campus, students from all walks of life can have access to the tertiary education and avail the opportunity to face the global challenge and lead a relatively high standard of living. To upgrade the students academically (using international collaboration), with etiquette and grooming, the prime objective is to help grow students professionally. The university helps them prepare for demanding corporate fields along with the development of their professional and rational skills.

Uttara University was founded by a Trustee Board. The members of the TRUST are educationists, economists and businessmen of eminence and recognition. Prof. Dr. M. Azizur Rahman is the Vice-Chancellor and founder Chairman of the Trustee Board and Prof. Dr. Eaysmin Ara Lekha is the founder Vice-Chairman of the Board.

Academic Scenario

'Quality Education at Affordable Tuition', is the slogan and motto of Uttara University. The creation of a knowledge-based society is the commitment of this university. So to achieve all these academic activities and research facilities along with international cooperation, we have been making relentless efforts since the inception of this University.

The permanent campus of Uttara University is in Gramvatulia, Turag, close to Sector#16, Uttara Model Town and the main campus is also in Sector#06, Road#15, Uttara, Dhaka-1230. The University has at present 05 Schools, 14 Departments and 34 Programs. These programs include courses on Humanities, Science, Engineering, Business, etc. The university prefers job-oriented and professional programs. It is the only university in Bangladesh, where the M.P.Ed program is being run with the help of foreign experts. Uttara University has opened departments like Electrical and Electronic Engineering, Civil Engineering, Fashion Design and Technology and offers quality education.

With a view to achieving quality education, Uttara University appoints highly qualified full time and adjunct faculties with degrees from home and abroad.

Computer Science Labs and English Lab

There are 32 labs in different departments of Uttara University. 6 computer labs are available for students' use, free of cost, and are equipped with state-of-the-art PCs, high-speed broadband backed by optical fiber network. Both students and teachers have free access to them. Recently, the campuses are covered with WiFi technology, where students are enjoying wireless connectivity.

Departments of Electrical and Electronic Engineering, Civil Engineering, Textile Department, English Department, Physics and Fashion Design and Technology have 8, 12, 12 and 7 labs respectively. FDT department is enriched with their 2 Pattern and Cutting Rooms, 2 Sewing Labs, Fashion and Illustration Room, Textile Lab and Computer Lab.

Digital System Lab

4 well-equipped digital system labs, along with different hardware equipments, are available for practical classes of engineering and IT courses. The labs are equipped with all necessary modern components so that students can get a feeling of the digital electronic lessons in a practical setting.

Library

The Central Library of the Uttara University, housed in the main building of the University, is equipped with rich collection of books and journals on Economics, Literature and Language, Social Science, Engineering, Religious Studies, Business, Health Education, Law, etc. The university library accommodates sufficient reference materials, periodicals to which students have easy access. Students are allowed to borrow books for use at home for a week or two.

Uttara University is a proud member of UGC Digital Library (UDL) and Research 4 Life. It includes ACM Digital Library, Emerald, IEEE Explore, EBSCO, Remotex etc. We have Seminar Library 07, Central Library 01, Total Books 40,278, eBook 3500 and Journals 893.

The Institutional Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Uttara University

The establishment of IQAC is an indispensable first step towards the development of internal quality assurance system of a university. Uttara University was awarded a project for establishment of the Institutional Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) on 14 June 2015. The IQAC of Uttara University is entrusted with the responsibility of ensuring quality education at all levels of the university through facilitating of Self-Assessment Activities of nine departments (Business Administration, Education,

Physical Education, English, Mathematics, Bangla, CSE, Islamic Studies and Law). After closing of HEQEP, IQAC has become an integral part of Uttara University since December 2018.

Center for Research and Training (CRT)

On 26.08.2017 Uttara University syndicate approved the establishment of Center for Research and Training (CRT). An Executive Committee (CRT Executive Committee) appointed by the Vice-Chancellor performs the functions of CRT headed by a Director and two additional directors who is responsible for the overall management of the Center.

International Collaboration:

Uttara University has achieved great success in terms of collaboration. It has created a new position to strengthen its capacity building in the area of 'International Collaboration'. The Director of 'International Collaboration' has been able to initiate dialogue with Coventry University. He has successfully signed Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Bedfordshire University and Orchester University UK. Recently four more MOU have been signed with the University of Malaya, University Kuala Lumpur (Malaysia), University of Hampton (USA) and National Institute of Fashion Technology (India) with the departments of Law, Business and FDT respectively. The authority is closely working with some Canadian Universities of international repute for collaboration, exchange programs and Credit Transfer as well.

Tuition Waiver/ Scholarship and Academic Award

Along with the facilities mentioned above, brilliant and meritorious but poor students are allowed Tuition Fee waiver/ Scholarship. Siblings and spouses are also getting waiver. Tribal, disabled, autistic and students from Freedom Fighters families are highly benefited by studying at Uttara University.

While continuing studies meritorious students are included in VC's and Dean's Award list for which they get financial support and certificate as per rules prepared for this purpose.

Co-Curricular Activities

Uttara University believes in proper development of the students along with their education. For their total development, university has established six different clubs for the students: namely UU Business Club, UU Sports Club, UU Cultural Club, UU Debating Club, UU Computer Club and UU Language Club. The clubs are fully operational with their different activities like Cricket Tournaments, National Football events, National Debating Championships, Cultural Program events, Business Plan competition etc. The students have successfully participated in those competitions. To build up the morality of the students, YES group guided by Transparency International Bangladesh is in active operation too.

9. One Civil Engineering student won first prize in International Drafting Competition participated by public and private university students held in International Islamic University (IUT).


Learning During Covid-19 induced Crisis

In the month of March 2020, a few days before the announcement and enforcement of complete lockdown. Following a long discussion in an emergency meeting, two committees were formed: Technical Committee (TACT) and Crisis Management Committee. TACT was responsible for making necessary IT facilities and services in place, arranging teachers' training for developing online teaching & evaluation skills, and providing guidelines for getting students connected to the online teaching-learning environment. CCC was responsible for maintaining contact with the students and guardians and providing them with necessary information time-to-time so that they were not panicked and could gradually adapt to new situation. Series of meetings were held with teachers and students to help them making a mental shift which was essential for performing professional work sitting at home environment. It should be noted that Uttara University could successfully continue its academic activities despite Covid-19 which induced irregularities.

Construction work of the permanent campus building is going on 7.21 bigha of land since 2020. It will be a palatial building having 3 basement and 12 stories. The academic area of the building will cover a floor area of 2,61,000 sq.ft.

To conclude it can be said that imparting education is a nobler task. Therefore, our commitment to this will go a long way in building a knowledge-based society and educated citizenry.


